20 or more payments to the parents. The nonpublic school or

24 (i) Transition.--The program of tuition grants under this
25 section shall continue if a school district exits a
26 receivership. The duties of the receiver under this section
27 shall transition to the local board of school directors.

28 (j) Notification.--No later than March 1, 2020, and each

1 March 1 thereafter, the receiver shall send written notification
2 to the parents of each student who is eligible to receive a
3 tuition grant under subsection (b) and post on the district's
4 publicly accessible Internet website all of the following
5 information:

6 (1) A description of the program of tuition grants.

7 (2) Instructions for applying for a tuition grant.

8 (3) Notice that a parent must directly contact a
9 nonpublic school or participating public school if the parent
10 seeks to enroll the student in a nonpublic school or
11 participating public school.
