- 22 Section 2501. Definitions.

23 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter 24 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the 25 context clearly indicates otherwise:

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- 27 "COVID-19 impacted business." A business materially impacted
- by the novel coronavirus known as COVID-19 identified in the 28
- 29 proclamation of disaster emergency issued by the Governor on
- March 6, 2020, published at 50 PA.B. 1644 (March 21, 2020), and 30
- 31 any renewal of the state of disaster emergency.

- 33 Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read:
- Section 2512. COVID-19 grant and loan programs. 34
- (a) COVID-19 grant program. -- From money appropriated to or 35

otherwise available to the authority for grants under this subsection, the authority shall make money available to community development financial institutions to make grants to COVID-19 impacted businesses. Grants under this subsection shall be used to provide technical assistance, training or other support.

- (b) COVID-19 loan program. -- From money appropriated to or otherwise available to the authority for loans under this subsection, the authority shall make money available to community development financial institutions to make loans to COVID-19 impacted businesses.
- (c) Report.--The authority shall prepare, in consultation with the committee, a report to the chairperson and minority chairperson of the Appropriations Committee of the Senate and the chairperson and minority chairperson of the Appropriations Committee of the House of Representatives. The report shall include the amount of money appropriated to the COVID-19 grant and loan programs under this section, the name and location of community development financial institutions accredited by the department and the number of grants and loans disbursed to COVID-19 impacted businesses.
- 22 <u>(d) Prohibition on issuance.--No grants or loans may be</u>
  23 <u>issued under this section 15 years after the effective date of</u>
  24 this section.
- 25 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
