7	(2) The board shall grant immediate operating authority
8	to the applicant to use the outside serving area subject to
9	the request while the board processes the request.
10	(3) The operating authority shall expire at the earliest
11	of any of the following:
12	(i) A valid protest is received.
13	(ii) The board determines that the proposed area
14	does not meet the requirements of this act and board
15	regulations for the licensing of the area in question.
16	(iii) The state of disaster emergency is terminated
17	or expires under 35 Pa.C.S. § 7301(c) (relating to
18	general authority of Governor).
19	(4) No filing fee shall be required from the applicant.
20	(5) The board may require the applicant to provide any
21	information that the board deems relevant.
22	(6) An outdoor serving area approved under this
23	subsection may only be utilized for purposes of outdoor
24	dining and may not include a kitchen or a bar.
