17 § 14. Absentee voting.

18 (a) The Legislature shall, by general law, provide a manner in which, and the time and place at which, qualified electors 19 20 [who may, on the occurrence of any election, be absent from the 21 municipality of their residence, because their duties, 22 occupation or business require them to be elsewhere or who, on 23 the occurrence of any election, are unable to attend at their proper polling places because of illness or physical disability 24 or who will not attend a polling place because of the observance 25 26 of a religious holiday or who cannot vote because of election 27 day duties, in the case of a county employee,] may vote, and for 28 the return and canvass of their votes in the election district 29 in which they respectively reside. A law under this subsection 30 may not require a qualified elector to physically appear at a designated polling place on the day of the election. 31

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(b) For purposes of this section, "municipality" means a
city, borough, incorporated town, township or any similar
general purpose unit of government which may be created by the
General Assembly.

5 Section 2. (a) Upon the first passage by the General 6 Assembly of these proposed constitutional amendments, the Secretary of the Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to 7 comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article 8 9 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the required advertisements to two newspapers in every county in 10 11 which such newspapers are published in sufficient time after 12 passage of these proposed constitutional amendments.

13 (b) Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of these 14 proposed constitutional amendments, the Secretary of the 15 Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the 16 17 Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the required 18 advertisements to two newspapers in every county in which such newspapers are published in sufficient time after passage of 19 20 these proposed constitutional amendments. The Secretary of the 21 Commonwealth shall:

22 Submit the proposed constitutional amendments under (1)23 section 1(1) of this resolution to the qualified electors of 24 this Commonwealth as a single ballot question at the first 25 primary, general or municipal election which meets the 26 requirements of and is in conformance with section 1 of 27 Article XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and which 28 occurs at least three months after the proposed 29 constitutional amendments are passed by the General Assembly.

30 (2) Submit the proposed constitutional amendments under 31 section 1(2) of this resolution to the qualified electors of 32 this Commonwealth as separate ballot questions at the first 33 primary, general or municipal election which meets the requirements of and is in conformance with section 1 of 34 35 Article XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and which 36 occurs at least three months after the proposed 37 constitutional amendments are passed by the General Assembly.
