1 Amend Bill, page 1, lines 6 through 18; page 2, lines 1  
2 through 10; by striking out all of said lines on said pages and

4 Section 1. Section 3354(d) (2.1) and (f) of Title 75 of the  
5 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended and the section  
6 is amended by adding a subsection to read:  
7 § 3354. Additional parking regulations.

9 (b.1) Protected pedestrian plazas and pedalcycle lanes.--

10 (1) If there is an on-street pedestrian plaza or a  
11 pedalcycle lane adjacent to the right-hand curb of a two-way  
12 or one-way highway, a vehicle standing or parked upon the  
13 right-hand side of the two-way or one-way highway shall be  
14 positioned in the direction of authorized traffic movement  
15 with the right-hand wheels of the vehicle parallel to and  
16 within 12 inches of the outside line of the buffer area  
17 between the pedestrian plaza or pedalcycle lane and parking.

18 (2) If there is an on-street pedestrian plaza or a  
19 pedalcycle lane adjacent to the left-hand curb of a one-way  
20 or median-divided, two-way highway, a vehicle standing or  
21 parked upon the left-hand side of the highway shall be  
22 positioned in the direction of authorized traffic movement  
23 with the left-hand wheels of the vehicle parallel to and  
24 within 12 inches of the outside line of the buffer area  
25 between the pedestrian plaza or pedalcycle lane and parking.

26 (3) Nothing under this section shall be deemed to  
27 prevent a local authority from enacting parking regulations  
28 under section 6109 (relating to specific powers of department  
29 and local authorities) to provide for a special, alternative  
30 or temporary configuration and signage for parking on a  
31 highway with an on-street pedestrian plaza or pedalcycle  
32 lane.

34 (d) Person with a disability and disabled veterans.--

35 \* \* \*

36 (2.1) Local authorities may limit access to a parking  
37 space reserved under paragraph (2) to a specific vehicle,

1 license plate or other method of designation. Under this  
2 paragraph, local authorities may charge a reasonable fee and  
3 shall comply with section 6109 [(relating to specific powers  
4 of department and local authorities)] and the Americans with  
5 Disabilities Act of 1990 (Public Law 101-336, 104 Stat. 327).

7 (f) Penalty.--A person violating subsection (a), (b), (b.1)  
8 or (d)(1) is guilty of a summary offense and shall, upon  
9 conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$15. A  
10 person violating subsection (d)(2) or (3) or (e) is guilty of a  
11 summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay  
12 a fine of not less than \$50 nor more than \$200. If a person is  
13 convicted under subsection (d)(2) or (3) in the absence of a  
14 sign stating the penalty amount, the fine imposed may not exceed  
15 \$50. A person violating subsection (d.1) is guilty of a summary  
16 offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine  
17 of not less than \$100 nor more than \$300.

19 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
