1 Amend Bill, page 1, line 4, by striking out the period after
2 "Bridge" and inserting

3 ; and designating a bridge on that portion of State Route 4011
4 over Pine Creek, Hegin Township, Schuylkill County, as the
5 A. Donald Buffington Memorial Bridge.

6 Amend Bill, page 2, by inserting between lines 20 and 21

7 Section 2. A. Donald Buffington Memorial Bridge.

8 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as
9 follows:

10 (1) A. Donald Buffington was born December 16, 1929.

11 (2) Mr. Buffington graduated in 1947 from the former
12 Hegin Township High School and in 1949 from the former
13 Eckles College of Mortuary Science, Philadelphia.

14 (3) Mr. Buffington faithfully served his community as a
15 board member of the Valley View Park Association and a board
16 member of the Tri-Valley School Board for several decades.

17 (4) Mr. Buffington spent several decades of time
18 maintaining the Valley View Park which included painting and
19 cutting grass.

20 (5) Mr. Buffington was a coach for the Hegin Valley
21 Teener League and was the first Teener League coach from
22 Schuylkill County to win the State Championship in 1970.

23 (6) Mr. Buffington played and coached semi-pro baseball
24 in the area for many years.

25 (7) Mr. Buffington was the Funeral Director for the
26 former Buffington Funeral Home and the Buffington-Reed
27 Funeral Home, both of Valley View.

28 (8) Mr. Buffington was a member of Friedens United
29 Church of Christ in Hegin, Valley View Gun Club and Valley
30 View Fire Company.

31 (b) Designation.--The bridge located on State Route 4011
32 over Pine Creek, Hegin Township, Schuylkill County, is
33 designated the A. Donald Buffington Memorial Bridge.

34 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
35 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to
36 traffic in both directions on the bridge.
