

## AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 742

1 Amend Bill, page 2, lines 7 through 20, by striking out all  
2 of said lines and inserting

3 (h) Revised State implementation plan.--Within 60 days of  
4 the effective date of this subsection, the Department of  
5 Environmental Protection shall initiate the process for emission  
6 inspection criteria for newest model year vehicles in the  
7 vehicle emission inspection and maintenance program. The  
8 following shall apply:

9 (1) The revised State implementation plan shall be  
10 completed no later than January 1, 2020, and shall  
11 convincingly demonstrate that the emission inspection  
12 criteria for newest model year vehicles can maintain the  
13 relevant standards without benefit of the emissions  
14 reductions attributable to the vehicle emission inspection  
15 and maintenance program.

16 (2) The Department of Environmental Protection shall  
17 comply with Federal law during the process, including  
18 ensuring that the revision will not interfere with attainment  
19 requirements or reasonable further progress toward attainment  
20 and that Federal funding is not negatively impacted as a  
21 result of the revision.

22 (3) The Department of Environmental Protection shall  
23 notify the chair and minority chair of the Transportation  
24 Committee of the Senate, the chair and minority chair of the  
25 Transportation Committee of the House of Representatives, the  
26 chair and minority chair of the Environmental Resources and  
27 Energy Committee of the Senate and the chair and minority  
28 chair of the Environmental Resources and Energy Committee of  
29 the House of Representatives of the Department of  
30 Environmental Protection's notification to the Environmental  
31 Protection Agency.
