29 which the action may be commenced by rule of court or
30 other judicial order prior to such effective date.

1 (3) An action commenced during the additional 30-day
2 periods specified under paragraph (2) (i), (ii) or (iii) shall
3 be deemed timely filed under section 5503(a) (relating to
4 commencement of matters).

5 (b) Applicability.--This section shall apply to any judicial
6 district for which a judicial emergency is declared. If a
7 Statewide judicial emergency is declared by a governing
8 authority, this section shall apply to all judicial districts.

9 (c) Construction.--Nothing in this section shall be
10 construed to reduce the time within which an action must be
11 commenced as established by any other law of this Commonwealth,
12 rule of court or other judicial order.
