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Amend Bill, page 1, lines 16 through 21; page 2, lines 1 1 2 through 14; by striking out all of said lines on said pages and 3 inserting Section 3102. Games of chance operations during COVID-19\_ 4 5 disaster emergency. 6 (a) Operations.--Notwithstanding the provisions of section 307 (b.2), during the COVID-19 disaster emergency, or until May 7 8 1, 2022, whichever is later, an eligible organization may conduct and reveal the winner of raffles and drawings via an 9 Internet-based conferencing software application in a manner 10 otherwise in accordance with this chapter. 11 (b) Raffles and drawings. -- The following shall apply to a 12 13 raffle or drawing authorized under subsection (a): (1) An eligible organization may use a mobile payment 14 service for the conduct or operation of the raffle or drawing 15 in accordance with subsection (c). An eligible organization 16 may not accept credit cards for the conduct or operation of 17 18 the raffle or drawing. 19 (2) An eligible organization may only use an Internet-20 based conferencing software application in the conduct of the raffle or drawing limited to the reveal of the winner of the 21 22 raffle or drawing. (3) The reveal of the winner of the raffle or drawing 23 shall not use or display animation in identifying the winner. 24 25 (4) The reveal of the winner of the raffle or drawing shall not use or display moving or still images in\_ 26 27 identifying the winner (5) The reveal of the winner of the raffle or drawing 28 29 shall not use, make or display a graphic presentation in 30 identifying the winner. 31 (6) The reveal of the winner of the raffle or drawing shall not use or be completed with the aid of a slot machine, 32 33 hybrid slot machine or skill slot machine as defined in 4 Pa.C.S. § 1103 (relating to definitions). 34 35 (7) The reveal of the winner of the raffle or drawing 36 shall not use or be completed with the aid of a video gaming 37 terminal as defined in 4 Pa.C.S. § 3102 (relating to

2	(8) The reveal of the winner of the raffle or drawing
3	shall not use or be completed with the aid of an electronic
4	<u>video monitor or a simulated gambling program as defined in</u>
5	<u>18 Pa.C.S. § 5513(f) (relating to gambling devices, gambling,</u>
6	<u>etc.).</u>
7	(c) Verification requirements In order to use a mobile
8	payment service under subsection (b)(1) for the conduct or
9	<u>operation of the raffle or drawing, an eligible organization</u>
10	shall take all of the following actions:
11	(1) Employ a mechanism to detect the physical location
12	<u>of a participant who buys a ticket for the raffle or drawing</u>
13	and block an individual located outside of this Commonwealth
14	from participating in the raffle or drawing. The eligible
15	<u>organization may not accept payment from an individual</u>
16	located outside of this Commonwealth.
17	<u>(2) Employ a mechanism to verify a participant's</u>
18	identity and record the document number of the participant's
19	<u>government-issued credential or employ any other methodology</u>
20	for remote, multi-sourced identity authentication, including
21	the use of a third party or government database.
22	(3) Employ a mechanism to verify that a participant is
23	<u>at least 18 years of age and block an individual under 18</u>
24	years of age from participating in the raffle or drawing. The
25	eligible organization may not accept payment from an
26	<u>individual under 18 years of age.</u>
27	(4) Require a participant to affirm that the information
28	provided by the participant under this subsection is
29	<u>accurate.</u>
30	(5) Record a participant's acknowledgment that the
31	information provided by the participant under this subsection
32	<u>is accurate.</u>
33	<u>(d) ExpirationThe authority granted under this section</u>
34	shall automatically expire upon expiration or termination of
35	the COVID-19 disaster emergency by executive order, proclamation
36	or operation of law, or May 1, 2022, whichever is later.
37	(e) DefinitionsAs used in this section, the following
38	words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
39	subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
40	"COVID-19 disaster emergency." The proclamation of disaster
41	emergency issued by the Governor on March 6, 2020, published at
42	50 Pa.B. 1644 (March 21, 2020), any renewal of the proclamation
43	of disaster emergency or any other proclamation of disaster
44	emergency related to the novel coronavirus, known as COVID-19,
45	issued by the Governor in accordance with 35 Pa.C.S. § 7301(c)
46	(relating to general authority of Governor).
47	"Drawing." A 50/50 drawing, daily drawing or weekly drawing.
48	"Internet-based conferencing software application." Any of
49	the following:
50	(1) A software application that allows for the
51	transmission of audio and visual communications between users

1	<u>over the Internet, including Zoom, Microsoft Teams, Skype or</u>
2	<u>an equivalent application.</u>
3	(2) A social networking application that allows for the
4	transmission of audio and visual communications between users
5	<u>over the Internet, including Facebook Live or Periscope.</u>
6	<u>"Mobile payment service." A service in which a money payment</u>
7	is made electronically through a money transfer service,
8	<u>including Venmo, PayPal, Cash App or an equivalent money</u>
9	transfer service.

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
