8 (j.1) Sovereign immunity.--

(1) Nothing in subsection (j) shall be construed to 9 require the department to issue a permit for a procession, 10 11 assemblage or special activity that will occur on a street, highway or real estate deemed by the department to be unsafe 12 for use by participants. The department, its servants and 13 agents, employees and representatives acting on its behalf 14 15 shall be immune from suit by participants for personal injuries or property damages arising during a procession, 16 17 assemblage or special activity permitted by the department 18 under 42 Pa.C.S. §§ 8521 (relating to sovereign immunity generally) and 8522 (relating to exceptions to sovereign 19 20 immunity). 21 (2) The term participants shall include spectators, event sponsors, municipal officials, police, fire police, 22 23 media and others present during the procession, assemblage or

24 special activity permitted by the department.
