

AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 996

Sponsor: REPRESENTATIVE JONES

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1 Amend Bill, page 1, line 18; page 2, lines 1 through 3; by
2 striking out all of said lines on said pages and inserting

3 "Lock-down phase." A period of time a long-term care
4 facility restricts visitation from the general public to
5 residents of the facility.

6 Amend Bill, page 2, line 8, by striking out "an older adult
7 daily living center," and inserting

8 or

9 Amend Bill, page 2, lines 9 and 10, by striking out "or an
10 intermediate care facility for individuals with intellectual
11 disabilities"

12 Amend Bill, page 2, by inserting between lines 10 and 11

13 "Member of the clergy." A clergyman, priest, rabbi,
14 minister, Christian Science practitioner, religious healer or
15 spiritual leader of any regularly established church or other
16 religious organization.

17 Amend Bill, page 2, line 23, by inserting after "section."

18 The department may update the protocols established under
19 this section at any time during the disaster emergency. The
20 department may not update the protocols established under this
21 section to expand the duration of the lock-down phase under
22 paragraph (2) for a time period exceeding 45 days.

23 Amend Bill, page 2, line 30, by inserting after "duration,"

24 set by the department, in consultation with the
25 Department of Human Services

26 Amend Bill, page 2, line 30, by striking out "30" and
27 inserting

28 45

1 Amend Bill, page 3, line 1, by inserting after "phase"
2 during which the long-term care facility may exclude
3 members of the clergy

4 Amend Bill, page 3, lines 6 and 7, by striking out "if the
5 requirements meet" in line 6 and all of line 7 and inserting
6 including limitations on the duration of the visits, the
7 number of visitors per week per resident, the location of visits
8 and the spacing of visitors. The requirements under this
9 subsection shall meet all of the following criteria:

10 Amend Bill, page 3, line 25, by inserting after "facility."

11 Personal protective equipment provided by the long-term care
12 facility may not reduce the personal protective equipment
13 available to the employees and staff of the long-term care
14 facility.

15 Amend Bill, page 3, line 28, by striking out "and" and
16 inserting

17 that results in a lock-down phase of long-term care
18 facilities until
