1 Amend Bill, page 1, lines 13 through 17; page 2, lines 1
2 through 7; by striking out "For the 2021-2022 2022-2023 school
3 year and" in line 13, all of lines 14 through 17 on page 1 and
4 all of lines 1 through 7 on page 2 and inserting

5 Beginning with the 2022-2023 school year and each school
6 year thereafter, a school entity shall post an Internet link or
7 title for every textbook used by the school entity, a course
8 syllabus or a written summary of each instructional course and
9 the State academic standards for each instructional course
10 offered by the school entity on its publicly accessible Internet
11 website. The information shall be updated no later than thirty
12 (30) business days after each time the list of textbooks,
13 syllabi, course descriptions or State academic standards used by
14 the school entity is revised.

15 Amend Bill, page 2, by inserting between lines 10 and 11

16 (c) In no case shall the requirements of this section be
17 construed to require a school entity to violate the copyright,
18 trademark or other intellectual property right of the creator or
19 owner of the curriculum.

20 Amend Bill, page 2, line 11, by striking out "(C)" and
21 inserting

23 Amend Bill, page 2, by inserting between lines 13 and 14
