

## AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 1665

6 subcontractors or suppliers," further providing for title of  
7 act and providing for indemnification agreements relating to  
8 snow removal or ice control services.

12 Section 1. The title of the act of July 9, 1970 (P.L.484,  
13 No.164), entitled "An act relating to indemnification agreements  
14 between architects, engineers or surveyors and owners,  
15 contractors, subcontractors or suppliers," is amended to read:

16 AN ACT

17 Relating to indemnification agreements between architects,  
18 engineers or surveyors and owners, contractors,  
19 subcontractors or suppliers and indemnification agreements  
20 relating to snow removal or ice control services.

21 Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read:

22 Section 1.1. The following apply to snow removal or ice  
23 control services:

24 (1) In a snow removal or ice control services contract  
25 between a provider and a receiver, any provision in the contract  
26 which provides that the receiver shall be indemnified, held  
27 harmless or insured by the provider from damages, claims, losses  
28 or expenses arising out of bodily injury to persons, damage to  
29 property or economic damage caused by or resulting from the  
30 receiver's negligences, in whole or in part, shall be void if  
31 the provider has been directed not to perform the snow removal  
32 or ice control services by the receiver.

33 (2) As used in this section, the term "snow removal or ice  
34 control services contract" means a contract or agreement for the  
35 performance of, or incidental to, any plowing of snow,

1 relocation of snow or other removal of snow or mixed  
2 precipitation from a surface or deicing services. The term  
3 includes moving snow removal or deicing equipment or materials.  
4 (3) For the purposes of this section, a provider of snow  
5 removal or ice control services shall include agents and  
6 employees of the provider.  
7 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
