

## AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 423

1 Amend Bill, page 1, line 10, by striking out "5706(a)(2)" and  
2 inserting

3 5706(a.1)

4 Amend Bill, page 2, lines 20 through 30; page 3, lines 1  
5 through 23; by striking out all of said lines on said pages

6 Amend Bill, page 3, by inserting between lines 23 and 24

7 (a.1) Return to State service during emergency.--When, in  
8 the judgment of the employer, an emergency creates an increase  
9 in the work load such that there is serious impairment of  
10 service to the public, an annuitant who is over normal  
11 retirement age or who has been an annuitant for more than [one  
12 year] six months may be returned to State service for a period  
13 not to exceed [95] 120 days in any calendar year without loss of  
14 his annuity. In computing the number of days an annuitant has  
15 returned to State service, any amount of time less than one-half  
16 of a day shall be counted as one-half of a day. For agencies,  
17 boards and commissions under the Governor's jurisdiction, the  
18 approval of the Governor that an emergency exists shall be  
19 required before an annuitant may be returned to State service.

20 Amend Bill, page 4, line 3, by striking out "or" and  
21 inserting a comma

22 Amend Bill, page 4, line 5, by inserting after "System"  
23 or eligible for membership or participation in an  
24 alternative retirement plan

25 Amend Bill, page 4, lines 10 through 14, by striking out  
26 "This act shall apply only to service as a State" in line 10 and  
27 all of lines 11 through 14 and inserting

28 This act shall not create in any member of the system or in  
29 any other person claiming an interest in the account of any

1 member of the system a contractual right, either express or  
2 implied.
