1 Amend Bill, page 1, line 9, by striking out the period after
2 "directors" and inserting
3 ; and making a repeal.

4 Amend Bill, page 1, lines 17 through 21; page 2, lines 1
5 through 13; by striking out all of said lines on said pages and
6 inserting

7 governed by a board of directors which shall consist of [11
8 members.] members appointed as follows:

9 (1) The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall
10 appoint two members from the House of Representatives, one
11 from the majority party and one from the minority party.

12 (2) The President pro tempore of the Senate shall
13 appoint two members from the Senate, one from the majority
14 party and one from the minority party.

15 (3) Two members shall be representatives of universities
16 in the State System of Higher Education. [One member]

17 (4) Two members shall be from The Pennsylvania State
18 University[.], one of whom shall be from Penn State
19 Extension.

20 (5) One member shall be from the University of
21 Pittsburgh. [One member shall be the Director of the
22 Northeast Regional Center for Rural Development.]

23 (6) The Governor shall appoint two members from among
24 the memberships of the following Statewide organizations:
25 Pennsylvania Rural Electric Association, Pennsylvania [Grange
26 Association] State Grange and the Pennsylvania Farm Bureau.

27 (7) One member shall be from the Northern Pennsylvania
28 Regional College.

29 (8) One member shall be from the Pennsylvania College of
30 Technology.

32 Section 2. Repeals are as follows:

33 (1) The General Assembly declares that the repeal under
34 paragraph (2) is necessary to effectuate the addition of
35 section 302(a) (7) and (8).

1 (2) Section 311 of the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177,
2 No.175), known as The Administrative Code of 1929, is
3 repealed.

4 Section 3. The addition of section 302(a)(7) and (8) is a
5 continuation of section 311 of the act of April 9, 1929
6 (P.L.177, No.175), known as The Administrative Code of 1929.
7 Except as otherwise provided in the addition of section 302(a)
8 (7) or (8) of the act, all activities initiated under section
9 311 of The Administrative Code of 1929 shall continue and remain
10 in full force and effect and may be completed under section
11 302(a)(7) or (8) of the act. Orders, regulations, rules and
12 decisions which were made under section 311 of The
13 Administrative Code of 1929 and in effect on the effective date
14 of section 2(2) of this act shall remain in full force and
15 effect until revoked, vacated or modified under section 302(7)
16 or (8) of the act. Contracts, obligations and collective
17 bargaining agreements entered into under section 311 of The
18 Administrative Code of 1929 are not affected nor impaired by the
19 repeal of section 311 of The Administrative Code of 1929.
