

## AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 532

1 Amend Bill, page 1, line 4, by striking out the period after  
2 "Bridge" and inserting  
3 ; and designating the portion of Pennsylvania Route 837, also  
4 known as Duquesne Boulevard, between Center Street in the  
5 City of Duquesne, Allegheny County, and Hoffman Boulevard in  
6 West Mifflin Borough, Allegheny County, as the Clifton P.  
7 Pitts Memorial Highway.

8 Amend Bill, page 2, by inserting between lines 14 and 15

9 Section 2. Clifton P. Pitts Memorial Highway.

10 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as  
11 follows:

12 (1) Clifton P. Pitts was born December 25, 1942, in  
13 Pittsburgh to the late Heywood and Sarah Bloss-Pitts and  
14 graduated from Duquesne Senior High School.

15 (2) After graduating high school, Mr. Pitts spent 21  
16 years working as the Director of Job Replacement for  
17 Allegheny County.

18 (3) Mr. Pitts later served as Director of the Mon-Yough  
19 Action Program, Director of the HIP program (Help Initiate  
20 Pride) and as a supervisor at Kool Vent Home Improvement  
21 where he retired in 2015.

22 (4) Clifton P. Pitts was a long-time Civil Rights leader  
23 in the Mon-Valley, where for more than 50 years he fought for  
24 equal housing, employment and education.

25 (5) Mr. Pitts previously served as President of the  
26 Duquesne-West Mifflin National Association for the  
27 Advancement of Colored People (NAACP) and Concerned Citizens.

28 (6) Mr. Pitts also served as First Jr. Exalted Ruler of  
29 the JT Brandy, Elk Lodge, JT Brandy Lodge; President of the  
30 Freshmen Society Club; past President of the Wild Bunch  
31 Social Club; past President of the Western Pennsylvania Black  
32 Assembly; and as Chairman of the Mon-Valley People Action  
33 Committee.

34 (7) On November 23, 2020, Clifton P. Pitts passed away  
35 at the age of 76.

36 (b) Designation.--The portion of Pennsylvania Route 837,  
37 also known as Duquesne Boulevard, between Center Street in the

1 City of Duquesne, Allegheny County, and Hoffman Boulevard in  
2 West Mifflin Borough, Allegheny County, is designated the  
3 Clifton P. Pitts Memorial Highway.

4 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and  
5 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the highway to  
6 traffic in both directions on the highway.
