8 (3) Ensure access to collected data, in the form of raw 9 data, dashboards and useful exportable reports, by State, 10 county and local governmental, public health and public safety stakeholders to real time data that may be used to 11 12 make actionable decisions in as close to real-time as 13 possible.

14 (4) Send automatic and immediate overdose spike-alerts 15 to preapproved State, county and local governmental, public 16 health and public safety leaders who may use the notification 17 to make decisions regarding how to respond to overdose 18 anomalies in their areas of responsibility. Initial 19 recommended spike thresholds shall be established using 20 relevant public health data. Local leaders shall have the 21 option to adjust the local spike threshold to fit the local 22 response plan needs.
