AN ACT

Amending Title 1 (General Provisions) of the Pennsylvania 1 2 Consolidated Statutes, providing for the distribution of 3 certain publications; making editorial changes; and making 4 appropriations. 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Section 501 of Title 1 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: 8 9 § 501. Publication and distribution. 10 General rule. -- The Legislative Reference Bureau may (a) 11 compile, edit, publish, print, supplement and revise or contract 12 directly or through the Legislative Printing Clerk for the 13 compilation, editing, publishing, printing, supplementation or 14 revision of an official publication of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes and amendments thereto. It shall be the 15 16 duty of the Department of [Property and Supplies] General

Services, upon request of the bureau, to arrange for the prompt

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distribution of the official publication and the supplements 1 thereto and revisions thereof in accordance with the provisions 2 3 of this chapter. [This publication shall be in addition to the 4 publication of advance copies of statutes and the Laws of 5 Pennsylvania except that the bureau, when authorized by concurrent resolution of the General Assembly, may reduce the 6 number of such statutes and laws published and printed and 7 provide for the manner of their distribution and a fee to be 8 charged for certain distributions.] 9

(b) Sale and distribution. -- The prices to be charged for 10 11 individual copies of and subscriptions to the official publication, the supplements thereto and revisions thereof, for 12 13 reprints and bound volumes thereof, which prices may be fixed without reference to the restrictions placed upon and fixed for 14 15 the sale of other publications of the Commonwealth, and the number of copies which shall be distributed free for official 16 17 use shall be established by the bureau. Without limiting the 18 generality of the foregoing, the bureau may provide for the free 19 [reciprocal]:

<u>(1) Reciprocal</u> exchange of publications between this
 Commonwealth and other states and foreign jurisdictions [and
 for the free distribution].

24 publication printed under authority of this chapter to each:
25 [(1)] (i) County for the use of its law library.
26 [(2)] (ii) Member of the General Assembly [at the

28 [(3)] (iii) Law school library which pursuant to

5 (c) Payments and disposition of moneys.--Payments for 6 documents published by authority of this chapter shall be made 7 to the Department of [Property and Supplies] <u>General Services</u> 8 which shall pay the same into the State Treasury to the credit 9 of the General Fund. Such moneys are hereby appropriated from 10 the General Fund to the Legislative Reference Bureau to carry 11 out the provisions of this chapter.

Section 2. The following sums are hereby specifically appropriated to the following agencies to carry out the purposes of 1 Pa.C.S. § 501(b)(3) (relating to publication and distribution) as added by this act:

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(2) Department of General Services, \$80,000.

(1) Legislative Reference Bureau, \$84,000.
