A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth
- of Pennsylvania, further providing for tenure of justices,
- judges and justices of the peace.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby resolves as follows:
- 6 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
- 7 Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI:
- 8 That section 15(a) of Article V be amended to read:
- 9 § 15. Tenure of justices, judges and justices of the peace.
- 10 (a) The regular term of office of justices [and judges shall
- 11 be ten years and the regular term of office for], judges, judges
- 12 of the municipal court in the City of Philadelphia and of
- 13 justices of the peace shall be six years. The tenure of any
- 14 justice or judge shall not be affected by changes in judicial
- 15 districts or by reduction in the number of judges.
- 16 * * *
- 17 Section 2. The following procedure applies to the proposed
- 18 constitutional amendment in this joint resolution:

- (1) Upon the first passage by the General Assembly of the amendment, the Secretary of the Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania.
- Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of 6 the amendment, the Secretary of the Commonwealth shall 7 proceed immediately to comply with the advertising 8 requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the Constitution 9 of Pennsylvania. The Secretary of the Commonwealth shall 10 11 submit the amendment to the qualified electors of this 12 Commonwealth at the first primary, general or municipal 13 election which meets the requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania. 14
