A RESOLUTION

1 Requesting the Liquor Control Board to refrain from issuing any
2 additional retail licenses for the sale of liquor or malt or
3 brewed beverages within the City of Philadelphia until an
4 investigation is conducted.

5 WHEREAS, Section 461(a) of the act of April 12, 1951 (P.L.90,
6 No.21), known as the Liquor Code, provides that licenses for
7 retail sale of liquor or malt or brewed beverages are limited to
8 one such license for each 3,000 inhabitants of a municipality;
9 and

10 WHEREAS, It appears that the number of such licenses held in
11 the City of Philadelphia now greatly exceeds this limitation;
12 therefore be it

13 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives request the
14 Liquor Control Board to refrain from issuing any additional
15 licenses in the City of Philadelphia pending an investigation of
16 this matter by the Liquor Control Committee; and be it further

17 RESOLVED, That the committee may hold hearings, take
18 testimony and make its investigations at such places as it deems

1 necessary in this Commonwealth. Each member of the committee
2 shall have power to administer oaths and affirmations to
3 witnesses appearing before the committee; and be it further
4 RESOLVED, That the committee make a report of its findings
5 and recommendations to the full House as soon as practicable.
