A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

- 1 Designating the week of March 12 through 18, 2023, as
- 2 "AmeriCorps Week" in Pennsylvania and expressing appreciation
- for AmeriCorps members and AmeriCorps Seniors volunteers
- 4 across this Commonwealth.
- 5 WHEREAS, Since the creation of AmeriCorps in 1993, the
- 6 AmeriCorps national service program has proven to be highly
- 7 effective in engaging Americans of all ages and backgrounds in
- 8 meeting a wide range of community needs and promoting the ethics
- 9 of service and volunteerism; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Each year, AmeriCorps, including AmeriCorps State
- 11 and National, AmeriCorps NCCC, AmeriCorps VISTA and AmeriCorps
- 12 Seniors, provides opportunities for 250,000 individuals across
- 13 the nation, including 11,300 in this Commonwealth, to give back
- 14 in an intensive way to communities, helping to improve the lives
- 15 of this Commonwealth's most vulnerable residents, strengthening
- 16 the educational system, protecting the environment and
- 17 contributing to public safety; and
- 18 WHEREAS, PennSERVE and the AmeriCorps agency have
- 19 strengthened this Commonwealth's private sector by investing

- 1 more than \$35 million this past year to support the efforts of
- 2 more than 1,400 nonprofit organizations, schools and community
- 3 groups, providing grants which leveraged more than \$14 million
- 4 in outside resources from businesses, foundations, public
- 5 agencies and other sources, strengthening community impact and
- 6 increasing the return on taxpayer dollars; and
- WHEREAS, AmeriCorps members nationwide, in return for their
- 8 service, have earned more than \$4 billion in Segal AmeriCorps
- 9 Education Awards to use to further their own educational
- 10 advancement at colleges and universities, including \$189 million
- 11 that have been awarded to residents of this Commonwealth; and
- 12 WHEREAS, After their terms of service end, AmeriCorps members
- 13 remain engaged in our communities as volunteers, teachers,
- 14 public servants and nonprofit leaders at disproportionately high
- 15 levels; and
- 16 WHEREAS, "AmeriCorps Week" is an opportune time for the
- 17 residents of this Commonwealth to salute AmeriCorps members and
- 18 AmeriCorps Seniors volunteers of the past and present for their
- 19 powerful impact and to thank all AmeriCorps community partners
- 20 in this Commonwealth who make the program possible and bring
- 21 more Americans into service; therefore be it
- 22 RESOLVED (the Senate concurring), That the General Assembly
- 23 designate the week of March 12 through 18, 2023, as "AmeriCorps
- 24 Week" in Pennsylvania and express appreciation for AmeriCorps
- 25 members and AmeriCorps Seniors volunteers across this
- 26 Commonwealth; and be it further
- 27 RESOLVED, That the General Assembly urge all residents of
- 28 this Commonwealth to thank AmeriCorps members and AmeriCorps
- 29 Seniors volunteers of the past and present for their service to
- 30 our communities.
