## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, providing for malicious mischief to
- 3 caves.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 18, act of November 25, 1970 (P.L.707, No.
- 7 230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, amended
- 8 December 6, 1972 (P.L.1482, No.334), is amended by adding a
- 9 section to read:
- 10 § 3307. Malicious mischief to caves.
- 11 Whoever without the prior permission of the owner, wilfully
- 12 or knowingly breaks, breaks off, cracks, carves upon, writes or
- 13 otherwise marks upon, or in any manner destroys, mutilates,
- 14 injures, defaces, mars or harms any natural material found in
- 15 any cave or cavern, such as stalactites, stalagmites,
- 16 helictites, anthodites, gypsum flowers or needles, flowstone,
- 17 draperies, columns, or other similar crystalline mineral
- 18 formations or otherwise and whoever kills, harms or disturbs
- 19 plant or animal life found therein, or discards litter or refuse

- therein, or otherwise disturbs or alters the natural condition
- 2 of such cave or cavern, or breaks, forces, tampers with,
- 3 <u>removes</u>, or otherwise disturbs a lock, gate, door or other
- 4 <u>structure or obstruction designed to prevent entrance to a cave</u>
- or cavern, without the permission of the owner thereof, whether 5
- or not entrance is gained, commits a misdemeanor of the third 6
- 7 degree.
- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
