A RESOLUTION

- 1 Proclaiming July 14, 1985, as "Ice Cream Day" in the
- 2 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania ranks first in the nation in the per
- $4\,$ capita consumption of ice cream, and second in its
- 5 manufacturing; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The production of ice cream is an outgrowth of the
- 7 Commonwealth's outstanding dairy industry which is a vital
- 8 component of the agricultural foundation upon which rests the
- 9 strength of our great Nation; and
- 10 WHEREAS, The dairy products produced in Pennsylvania
- 11 contribute significantly to the economy of the State and the
- 12 well-being of all its citizens; and
- 13 WHEREAS, The President and the United States Congress have
- 14 officially designated July as "National Ice Cream Month" and
- 15 July 14th as "National Ice Cream Day"; therefore be it
- 16 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives, representing the

- 1 citizens of the great Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, recognize
- 2 the contribution of the ice cream industry to the quality of
- 3 life in the State; and be it further
- 4 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the
- 5 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania proclaim July 14, 1985, as "Ice
- 6 Cream Day" in Pennsylvania.
