AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, providing for unmarked police vehicles.

3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4 hereby enacts as follows:

5 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
6 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

7 § 3327. Unmarked police vehicles.

8 The Pennsylvania State Police shall promulgate regulations
9 for the use of unmarked police vehicles. The regulations shall
10 do all of the following:

11 (1) Set the procedure used by a police officer in an
12 unmarked police vehicle to stop a motorist. This paragraph
13 includes all of the following:

14 (i) Use of siren and lights.

15 (ii) Wearing of uniform.

16 (iii) Proper display of identification or badge.

17 (2) Inform motorists of proper action to take when they

1 believe they are being stopped by someone other than a police
2 officer.
3 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
