## AN ACT

Amending the act of October 27, 1955 (P.L.744, No.222), 1 2 entitled, as amended, "An act prohibiting certain practices 3 of discrimination because of race, color, religious creed, 4 ancestry, age or national origin by employers, employment 5 agencies, labor organizations and others as herein defined; б creating the Pennsylvania Human Relations Commission in the 7 Department of Labor and Industry; defining its functions, powers and duties; providing for procedure and enforcement; 8 9 providing for formulation of an educational program to 10 prevent prejudice; providing for judicial review and enforcement and imposing penalties," providing for the use of 11 12 support dogs because of a physical handicap of the user.

13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

14 hereby enacts as follows:

15 Section 1. Sections 2, 3 and 5(h) and (i) of the act of

16 October 27, 1955 (P.L.744, No.222), known as the Pennsylvania

17 Human Relations Act, amended April 8, 1982 (P.L.284, No.80), are

18 amended to read:

19 Section 2. Findings and Declaration of Policy.--

20 (a) The practice or policy of discrimination against

21 individuals or groups by reason of their race, color, religious

creed, ancestry, handicap or disability, use of guide dogs 1 because of blindness or deafness of the user, use of support 2 3 dogs because of a physical handicap of the user, age, sex, or 4 national origin is a matter of concern of the Commonwealth. Such 5 discrimination foments domestic strife and unrest, threatens the rights and privileges of the inhabitants of the Commonwealth, 6 and undermines the foundations of a free democratic state. The 7 denial of equal employment, housing and public accommodation 8 9 opportunities because of such discrimination, and the consequent 10 failure to utilize the productive capacities of individuals to 11 their fullest extent, deprives large segments of the population of the Commonwealth of earnings necessary to maintain decent 12 13 standards of living, necessitates their resort to public relief 14 and intensifies group conflicts, thereby resulting in grave 15 injury to the public health and welfare, compels many 16 individuals to live in dwellings which are substandard, unhealthful and overcrowded, resulting in racial segregation in 17 18 public schools and other community facilities, juvenile 19 delinquency and other evils, thereby threatening the peace, 20 health, safety and general welfare of the Commonwealth and its inhabitants. 21

22 (b) It is hereby declared to be the public policy of this 23 Commonwealth to foster the employment of all individuals in 24 accordance with their fullest capacities regardless of their 25 race, color, religious creed, ancestry, handicap or disability, 26 use of guide dogs because of blindness or deafness of the user, 27 use of support dogs because of a physical handicap of the user, age, sex, or national origin, and to safeguard their right to 28 29 obtain and hold employment without such discrimination, to 30 assure equal opportunities to all individuals and to safequard - 2 -19850H0141B0155

their rights at places of public accommodation and to secure
commercial housing regardless of race, color, religious creed,
ancestry, sex, handicap or disability, use of guide dogs because
of blindness or deafness of the user or national origin.

5 (c) This act shall be deemed an exercise of the police power 6 of the Commonwealth for the protection of the public welfare, 7 prosperity, health and peace of the people of the Commonwealth 8 of Pennsylvania.

9 Section 3. Right to Freedom from Discrimination in 10 Employment, Housing and Places of Public Accommodation .-- The 11 opportunity for an individual to obtain employment for which he is qualified, and to obtain all the accommodations, advantages, 12 facilities and privileges of any place of public accommodation 13 14 and of commercial housing without discrimination because of 15 race, color, religious creed, ancestry, handicap or disability, 16 age, sex or national origin are hereby recognized as and 17 declared to be civil rights which shall be enforceable as set 18 forth in this act.

19 The opportunity of an individual to obtain all the 20 accommodations, advantages, facilities and privileges of 21 commercial housing without discrimination due to the sex of an 22 individual, or to the use of a guide dog because of blindness or 23 deafness of the user, or to the use of a support dog because of a physical handicap of the user, is hereby recognized as and 24 25 declared to be a civil right which shall be enforceable as set 26 forth in this act.

Section 5. Unlawful Discriminatory Practices.--It shall be an unlawful discriminatory practice, unless based upon a bona fide occupational qualification, or in the case of a fraternal corporation or association, unless based upon membership in such 19850H0141B0155 - 3 - association or corporation, or except where based upon
applicable security regulations established by the United States
or the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania:

5 (h) For any person to:

Refuse to sell, lease, finance or otherwise to deny or 6 (1)7 withhold commercial housing from any person because of the race, color, religious creed, ancestry, sex, national origin or 8 9 handicap or disability of any prospective owner, occupant or 10 user of such commercial housing, or to refuse to lease 11 commercial housing to any person due to use of a guide dog because of the blindness or deafness of the user, or use of a 12 13 support dog because of a physical handicap of the user.

14 (2) Refuse to lend money, whether or not secured by mortgage 15 or otherwise for the acquisition, construction, rehabilitation, 16 repair or maintenance of commercial housing or otherwise 17 withhold financing of commercial housing from any person because 18 of the race, color, religious creed, ancestry, sex, national 19 origin or handicap or disability of any present or prospective 20 owner, occupant or user of such commercial housing.

21 (3) Discriminate against any person in the terms or 22 conditions of selling or leasing any commercial housing or in 23 furnishing facilities, services or privileges in connection with 24 the ownership, occupancy or use of any commercial housing 25 because of the race, color, religious creed, ancestry, sex, 26 national origin or handicap or disability of any present or 27 prospective owner, occupant or user of such commercial housing or to discriminate against any person in the terms of leasing 28 any commercial housing or in furnishing facilities, services or 29 30 privileges in connection with the occupancy or use of any 19850H0141B0155 - 4 -

commercial housing due to use of a guide dog because of the
blindness or deafness of the user, or use of a support dog
because of a physical handicap of the user.

4 (4) Discriminate against any person in the terms or 5 conditions of any loan of money, whether or not secured by mortgage or otherwise for the acquisition, construction, 6 rehabilitation, repair or maintenance of commercial housing 7 because of the race, color, religious creed, ancestry, sex, 8 national origin or handicap or disability of any present or 9 10 prospective owner, occupant or user of such commercial housing. 11 (5) Print, publish or circulate any statement or 12 advertisement relating to the sale, lease or acquisition of any 13 commercial housing or the loan of money, whether or not secured 14 by mortgage, or otherwise for the acquisition, construction, 15 rehabilitation, repair or maintenance of commercial housing 16 which indicates any preference, limitation, specification, or 17 discrimination based upon race, color, religious creed, 18 ancestry, sex, national origin or handicap or disability, or to 19 print, publish or circulate any statement or advertisement 20 relating to the lease of any commercial dwelling which indicates 21 any preference, limitation, specification or discrimination 22 based upon use of a guide dog because of the blindness or deafness of the user, or use of a support dog because of a 23 24 physical handicap of the user.

(6) Make any inquiry, elicit any information, make or keep any record or use any form of application, containing questions or entries concerning race, color, religious creed, ancestry, sex, national origin or handicap or disability in connection with the sale or lease of any commercial housing or loan of any money, whether or not secured by mortgage or otherwise for the 19850H0141B0155 - 5 -

acquisition, construction, rehabilitation, repair or maintenance 1 of commercial housing, or to make any inquiry, elicit any 2 information, make or keep any record or use any form of 3 application, containing questions or entries concerning the use 4 5 of a quide dog because of the blindness or deafness of the user, or use of a support dog because of a physical handicap of the 6 7 user, in connection with the lease of any commercial housing. 8 (i) For any person being the owner, lessee, proprietor, 9 manager, superintendent, agent or employe of any place of public 10 accommodation, resort or amusement to:

11 (1) Refuse, withhold from, or deny to any person because of his race, color, sex, religious creed, ancestry, national origin 12 13 or handicap or disability, or to any person due to use of a 14 guide dog because of the blindness or deafness of the user, or 15 use of a support dog because of a physical handicap of the user, 16 either directly or indirectly, any of the accommodations, advantages, facilities or privileges of such place of public 17 18 accommodation, resort or amusement.

19 (2) Publish, circulate, issue, display, post or mail, either 20 directly or indirectly, any written or printed communication, 21 notice or advertisement to the effect that any of the 22 accommodations, advantages, facilities and privileges of any such place shall be refused, withheld from or denied to any 23 person on account of race, color, religious creed, ancestry, 24 25 national origin or handicap or disability, or to any person due 26 to use of a guide dog because of the blindness or deafness of the user, or use of a support dog because of a physical handicap 27 28 of the user, or that the patronage or custom thereat of any 29 person, belonging to or purporting to be of any particular race, 30 color, religious creed, ancestry, national origin or handicap or 19850H0141B0155 – б –

1 disability, or to any person due to use of a guide dog because 2 of the blindness or deafness of the user, is unwelcome, 3 objectionable or not acceptable, desired or solicited. 4 \* \* \*

5 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
