AN ACT

1 Amending Title 34 (Game) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
2 Statutes, further providing for organization of the  
3 Pennsylvania Game Commission.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 301(c) of Title 34 of the Pennsylvania  
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

8 § 301. Organization of commission.

9 \* \* \*

10 (c) Term of office and compensation.--

11 (1) [The members] A member of the commission shall hold  
12 office for not more than two terms of [eight] four years  
13 each, subject to Senate confirmation pursuant to law for each  
14 term, and may continue to hold office for a period of time  
15 not to exceed [six] 12 months or until a successor is  
16 appointed and qualified, whichever occurs first. Thereafter,  
17 the person shall be ineligible to hold that office.

18 (2) A member of the commission appointed to fill a

1 vacancy for a period of [four] two years or less may be  
2 eligible for appointment to a full [eight-year] four-year  
3 term. [A member of the commission who serves a full eight-  
4 year term or fills a vacancy for a period of more than four  
5 years shall not be eligible for reappointment to the  
6 commission until a period of eight years expires.]

7 (3) Commissioners shall receive no compensation for  
8 their services, but may be reimbursed for travel expenses.

9 \* \* \*

10 Section 2. The amendment of 34 Pa.C.S. § 301(c) shall apply  
11 to members of the commission appointed on or after the effective  
12 date of this section.

13 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
