AN ACT

1 Amending the act of December 4, 1996 (P.L.911, No.147), entitled
2 "An act providing for registration requirements for
3 telemarketers and for powers and duties of the Office of
4 Attorney General," further providing for unwanted telephone
5 solicitation calls prohibited.

6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
7 hereby enacts as follows:

8 Section 1. Section 5.2(k) of the act of December 4, 1996
9 (P.L.911, No.147), known as the Telemarketer Registration Act,
10 is amended by adding a paragraph to read:

11 Section 5.2. Unwanted telephone solicitation calls prohibited.

13 (k) Investigation, enforcement and reporting.--

14 * * *

15 (4) The Attorney General shall establish ongoing

1 communication with the Department of Aging in order to ensure
2 that consumers who are 60 years of age or older have access
3 to ~~services available through the department~~ INFORMATION <--
4 REGARDING THE PREVENTION OF POTENTIAL PATTERNS OF FINANCIAL
5 EXPLOITATION. The Attorney General shall coordinate with the
6 Secretary of Aging to determine the most effective and
7 efficient manner in which information shall be shared, while
8 ensuring strict adherence to rules of confidentiality.
9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
