## AN ACT

Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 2 Statutes, prohibiting a vehicle insurer from charging a 3 deductible, canceling or refusing to renew a policy or 4 applying a surcharge or driver record point assignments under 5 certain circumstances. 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 7 hereby enacts as follows: 8 Section 1. Section 1799.3 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read: § 1799.3. Limit on cancellations, refusals to renew, refusals 10 to write, surcharges, rate penalties and point 11 12 assignments. 13 14 (a.1) Prohibitions. -- No insurer shall charge a deductible, 15 cancel or refuse to renew a policy or apply any surcharge, rate penalty or driver record point assignment where any of the 16

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following apply:

- 1 (1) The insured is not responsible for any person
- 2 injured.
- (2) The insured is not responsible for any property 3
- 4 damage incurred.
- 5 (3) Injury or property damage is determined to be the
- 6 fault of an unidentified motorist.

- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
