## AN ACT

7	Section 1. Section 1124, act of February 1, 1966 (1965,
8	P.L.1656, No.581), known as "The Borough Code" is amended to

10	Section 1124. Suspension by MayorIn addition to the
11	powers of council to suspend policemen, the mayor may, for cause
12	and without pay, suspend any policemen until the succeeding
13	regular meeting of the council, at which time or thereafter the
14	council may, subject to the civil service provisions of this
15	act, if they be in effect at the time, suspend, discharge,
16	reduce in rank or reinstate with pay, such policemen: <u>Provided,</u>
17	however, That a policeman suspended by the mayor may not be
18	<u>reinstated by council at a date earlier than ten working days</u>

from the date fixed by the mayor for the suspension to commence.
In any case where the council has reinstated a policeman, after
having been suspended by the mayor, the mayor shall not
thereafter suspend such policeman for reasons arising from the
same act for which the first suspension was made, or for reasons
that the council, in reinstating such policeman, shall have
determined not to be grounds for suspension.

8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
