AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, further providing for junk vehicle towers.

3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4 hereby enacts as follows:

5 Section 1. Subsection (c) of section 1337 of Title 75, act
6 of November 25, 1970 (P.L.707, No.230), known as the
7 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, is amended to read:

8 § 1337. Use of "Miscellaneous Motor Vehicle Business"
9 registration plates.

11 (c) Classes of "Miscellaneous Motor Vehicle Business".--

12 (1) Repair, service and towing.--Any person engaged in
13 the repair, service or towing of motor vehicles.

14 (2) Vehicle salvage dealer.--Any person who maintains an
15 established place of business and who is engaged in the
16 business of buying, selling or exchanging used, wrecked or
17 abandoned vehicles and junkers for the purpose of remodeling,
18 taking apart, or rebuilding the same, or buying or selling of

1 parts.

2 (3) Transporter.--A person regularly engaged in the
3 business of transporting new vehicles or new and used
4 trailers on their own wheels, owned by or in possession of a
5 registered dealer.

6 (4) Financier or collector-repossessor.--A person who is
7 duly authorized to do business in this Commonwealth as a
8 financier or collector-repossessor and who is regularly
9 engaged in the business of financing sales, making loans on
10 the security of vehicles or repossessing vehicles which are
11 the subject of installment sales contracts as an independent
12 contractor.

13 (5) Junk vehicle tower.--A person who is engaged in the
14 business of towing wrecked or junked vehicles to or from the
15 premises of a vehicle salvage dealer. It shall not be a
16 requirement for a registration plate under this paragraph
17 that a junk vehicle tower maintain an office or other
18 business establishment separate and apart from his residence.

19 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
