AN ACT

Amending the act of June 28, 1895 (P.L.408, No.289), entitled,

12	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
13	hereby enacts as follows:
14	Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 2, act of June 28, 1895
15	(P.L.408, No.289), entitled, as amended, "A supplement to the

- 3 Section 2. (a) On and after the first day of January, one
- 4 thousand nine hundred and nineteen, and annually thereafter,
- 5 there shall be paid by the State Treasurer to the treasurers of
- 6 the several cities, towns, townships, and boroughs within the
- 7 Commonwealth, the entire net amount received from the two per
- 8 centum tax paid upon premiums by foreign fire insurance
- 9 companies. The amount to be paid to each of the treasurers of
- 10 the several cities, towns, townships, and boroughs shall be
- 11 [based upon the return of said two per centum tax upon premiums
- 12 received from foreign fire insurance companies doing business
- 13 within the said cities, towns, townships, and boroughs, and
- 14 shall be proportionate to the premiums received by such
- 15 companies on account of insurance written upon property located
- 16 in such city, borough, town or township, as shown by the report
- 17 made to the Department of Revenue.] distributed as follows:
- 18 fifty per centum in accordance to the population of the several
- 19 cities, towns, townships and boroughs based on the latest
- 20 <u>national population census as reported by the Bureau of Census</u>
- 21 of the Unites States, and fifty per centum in accordance with
- 22 the market value of taxable real property of the several cities,
- 23 towns, townships and boroughs, as determined by the State Tax
- 24 Equalization Board. Each city, borough, town or township,
- 25 receiving any payment from the State Treasurer hereunder, shall
- 26 forthwith pay the amount received to the relief fund association
- 27 of, or the pension fund covering the employes of the fire
- 28 department, or of such fire company, or fire companies, paid or
- 29 volunteer, now existing, or hereafter organized, in such city,
- 30 borough, town, or township, as is or are engaged in the service

- 1 of such city, borough, town, or township, and duly recognized as
- 2 such by the council or commissioners or supervisors, as the case
- 3 may be, of such city, borough, town, or township. In any
- 4 borough, town or township in which there is no fire department
- 5 or fire company or companies, the amount received by the
- 6 treasurer of the borough, town or township from said tax shall
- 7 be forthwith paid to the relief fund association, or pension
- 8 fund of the fire department or fire company or companies of any
- 9 near or adjacent city, borough, town, or township, the fire
- 10 department or fire company or companies of which afford fire
- 11 protection to the inhabitants of such borough, town, or
- 12 township. Before payment of said tax to the treasurer of any
- 13 such borough, town, or township, the mayor, in boroughs, and the
- 14 secretary of the board of supervisors, in towns, or townships,
- 15 shall first certify to the Auditor General that the fire
- 16 department or fire company or companies of such near or adjacent
- 17 city, borough, town, or township afford fire protection to the
- 18 inhabitants of such borough, town, or township: Provided, That
- 19 if the fire department consists of paid and volunteer firemen
- 20 and the paid firemen shall be covered by a pension fund, then
- 21 the two per centum tax aforesaid shall be divided equally
- 22 between the relief fund association of the volunteer firemen and
- 23 the pension fund for the paid firemen. Warrants for the above
- 24 purposes shall be drawn by the Auditor General, payable to the
- 25 treasurers of the several cities, towns, townships, and
- 26 boroughs, in accordance with this act, whenever there are
- 27 sufficient funds in the State Treasury to pay the same
- 28 commencing January 1, 1980. All such fire insurance companies
- 29 shall instruct their agents to place conspicuously upon the said
- 30 policies and in the applications for said policies, if any, the

- 1 exact name of the city, borough, town or township wherein the
- 2 insured property is located in addition to the mailing address
- 3 for said insured property.
