## AN ACT

- Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in assault, further providing for the
- 3 offense of ethnic intimidation.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 2710(a) and (c) of Title 18 of the
- 7 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:
- 8 § 2710. Ethnic intimidation.
- 9 (a) Offense defined. -- A person commits the offense of ethnic
- 10 intimidation if, with malicious intention toward the race,
- 11 color, religion [or], national origin or physical or mental
- 12 disability of another individual or group of individuals, he
- 13 commits an offense under any other provision of this article or
- 14 under Chapter 33 (relating to arson, criminal mischief and other
- 15 property destruction) exclusive of section 3307 (relating to
- 16 institutional vandalism) or under section 3503 (relating to
- 17 criminal trespass) with respect to such individual or his or her
- 18 property or with respect to one or more members of such group or

- 1 to their property.

- 3 (c) Definition.--As used in this section "malicious
- 4 intention" means the intention to commit any act, the commission
- 5 of which is a necessary element of any offense referred to in
- 6 subsection (a) motivated by hatred toward the race, color,
- 7 religion [or], national origin or physical or mental disability
- 8 of another individual or group of individuals.
- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
