A RESOLUTION

- 1 Designating November 25, 2017, as "Elimination of Violence
- 2 Against Women Day" in Pennsylvania to coincide with the
- 3 United Nations' "International Day for the Elimination of
- 4 Violence Against Women."
- 5 WHEREAS, The House of Representatives acknowledges the
- 6 global, State and local imperative to prevent and end gender-
- 7 based discrimination and violence; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Violence affecting one in three women globally is
- 9 one of the main mechanisms denying equality; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Violence against women includes acts that can cause
- 11 physical, sexual or psychological harm in public or private
- 12 life; and
- 13 WHEREAS, In its various forms, violence against women
- 14 fractures families and communities and impacts progress toward
- 15 poverty reduction, peace and security; and

- 1 WHEREAS, The General Assembly of the United Nations
- 2 recognizes numerous international frameworks and instruments
- 3 defining the obligation of member states to prevent and respond
- 4 to violence against women; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Former United Nations Secretary-General Ban Ki-moon
- 6 noted that sustainable development goals are not achieved
- 7 without addressing the rights of women in law and in practice;
- 8 and
- 9 WHEREAS, November 25 has been designated and is annually
- 10 observed as the date for the international observance; and
- 11 WHEREAS, This date commemorates the 1960 assassination of
- 12 Patria, Minerva and Maria Teresa Mirabal from the Dominican
- 13 Republic during the Rafael Trujillo dictatorship; and
- 14 WHEREAS, The Mirabal sisters have come to symbolize popular
- 15 resistance against the victimization of women; and
- 16 WHEREAS, The Office on Women's Health of the United States
- 17 Department of Health and Human Services works with other
- 18 Federal, State and local agencies to stop violence against women
- 19 and girls; and
- 20 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Coalition Against Domestic Violence
- 21 and the Pennsylvania Coalition Against Rape advocate for the
- 22 rights and needs of female victims of violence and work to break
- 23 cycles of violence in this Commonwealth; and
- 24 WHEREAS, The House of Representatives reaffirms its
- 25 commitment to protect women affected by violence and to prevent
- 26 acts of discrimination and violence against women; therefore be
- 27 it
- 28 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate
- 29 November 25, 2017, as "Elimination of Violence Against Women
- 30 Day" in Pennsylvania to coincide with the United Nations'
