A RESOLUTION

Designating the week of December 26, 2017, through January 1, 2018, as "Kwanzaa Week" in Pennsylvania, in recognition of 2 the cultural significance of this holiday for African people 3 throughout the world. 4 5 WHEREAS, Kwanzaa is an African-American holiday which celebrates family, community and culture and is observed each 6 year by millions throughout the world; and 8 WHEREAS, The name Kwanzaa is derived from the phrase matunda ya kwanza, which means first fruits of the harvest in Swahili, 10 the most widely spoken African language; and WHEREAS, First-fruits celebrations are recorded in African 11 12 history as early as ancient Egypt and Nubia and appear in ancient and modern times in other classical African 13 14 civilizations, including Ashantiland and Yorubaland; and 15 WHEREAS, Kwanzaa is a cultural holiday, not a religious one,

WHEREAS, Kwanzaa is a profound expression of African people

and is open to all religious faiths; and

- 4 WHEREAS, The Kwanzaa celebration was created to introduce and
- 5 reinforce the seven values of unity, self-determination,
- 6 collective work and responsibility, cooperative economics,
- 7 purpose, creativity and faith; and
- 8 WHEREAS, The Kwanzaa celebration is a time for commemorating
- 9 the past in pursuit of its lessons, celebrating the goodness of
- 10 life, family, community and culture and reaffirming the bonds
- 11 between people; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Kwanzaa is a time of special reverence for the
- 13 creator and creation in thanks for the blessings and bounty of
- 14 the earth; and
- WHEREAS, The year 2017 marks the 51st anniversary of this
- 16 annual holiday; and
- 17 WHEREAS, This represents a time set aside for committing to
- 18 our highest ideals and an effort to bring forth the best in
- 19 African cultural practice; therefore be it
- 20 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 21 week of December 26, 2017, through January 1, 2018, as "Kwanzaa
- 22 Week" in Pennsylvania, in recognition of the cultural
- 23 significance of this holiday for African people throughout the
- 24 world.
