- 1 § 501. Definitions.
- 2 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
- 3 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 4 <u>context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 5 "Department." The Department of State of the Commonwealth.
- 6 <u>"Election Day." The day of a general election, municipal</u>
- 7 <u>election or primary election.</u>
- 8 <u>"General election." The election held biennially on the</u>
- 9 Tuesday next following the first Monday of November in each
- 10 even-numbered year.
- 11 "Municipal corporation." A city, borough, incorporated town
- 12 <u>or township.</u>
- 13 "Municipal election." The election held on the Tuesday next
- 14 following the first Monday of November in each odd-numbered
- 15 year.
- 16 "Primary election." An election for the nomination of
- 17 candidates.
- 18 "Private employer." An employer that is engaged in business
- 19 in this Commonwealth. The term does not include a public
- 20 employer, school district or county.
- 21 "Public employer."
- 22 (1) Any of the following:
- (i) The Commonwealth.
- 24 (ii) A municipal corporation.
- 25 (2) The term does not include a county or school
- 26 district.
- 27 § 502. Observance of Election Day as a legal holiday.
- 28 (a) General rule. -- A public employer shall observe Election
- 29 <u>Day as a legal holiday.</u>
- 30 (b) Other public entities. -- A school district or county may

- 1 <u>observe Election Day as a legal holiday.</u>
- 2 <u>(c) Private employers.--</u>
- 3 (1) On Election Day, a private employer shall provide no
- 4 <u>less than two hours of unpaid leave to its employees for the</u>
- 5 purpose of voting.
- 6 (2) A private employer that violates paragraph (1) shall
- 7 pay a civil penalty of not less than \$1,000 to the county
- 8 <u>board of elections.</u>
- 9 <u>(d) Enforcement.--The department shall enforce the</u>
- 10 provisions of this section and may promulgate regulations
- 11 <u>necessary to enforce the provisions of this section.</u>
- 12 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
