A SUPPLEMENT

To the act of May 29, 2020 (P.L., No.1A), entitled "An act to provide appropriations from the General Fund for the expenses 2 of the Executive, Legislative and Judicial Departments of the 3 Commonwealth, the public debt and the public schools for the 4 5 fiscal year July 1, 2020, to June 30, 2021, and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close 6 7 of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020; to provide appropriations from special funds and accounts to the 8 Executive and Judicial Departments for the fiscal year July 9 1, 2020, to June 30, 2021, and for the payment of bills 10 remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending June 11 30, 2020; to provide for the appropriation of Federal funds 12 to the Executive and Judicial Departments for the fiscal year 13 July 1, 2020, to June 30, 2021, and for the payment of bills 14 remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending June 15 30, 2020; and to provide for the additional appropriation of 16 17 Federal and State funds to the Executive and Judicial Departments for the fiscal year July 1, 2019, to June 30, 18 2020, and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining 19 unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019," 20 adding Federal appropriations to the Executive Department of 21 the Commonwealth for the fiscal year July 1, 2020, to June 22 30, 2021. 23 24 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 25 hereby enacts as follows: 26 PART I 27 GENERAL PROVISIONS

Section 101. Short title.

- 13 necessary, are specifically appropriated from the special funds

- 15 Department of the Commonwealth for the payment of salaries,
- 16 wages or other compensation and travel expenses of the duly
- 17 appointed officers and employees of the Commonwealth, for the
- 18 payment of fees for contractual services rendered, for the
- 19 purchase or rental of goods and services and for payment of any
- 20 other expenses, as provided by law or by this act, necessary for
- 21 the proper conduct of the duties, functions and activities and
- 22 for the purposes specified in this act for the current fiscal
- 23 year and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid
- 24 at the close of the prior fiscal year.

- 1 Section 302. Applicability.
- 2 Except as otherwise provided in section 301, the provisions
- 3 of the act of May 29, 2020 (P.L. ,No.1A), known as the General
- 4 Appropriation Act of 2020, shall apply to this act.
- 5 Section 303. Effective date.
- 6 This act shall take effect immediately.
