A RESOLUTION

Recognizing April 29, 2016, as "Arbor Day"; promoting public 1 participation in the celebration; and further recognizing the 2 value of trees to our environment. 3 4 WHEREAS, The tree has proved to be a valuable component of 5 our environment by providing us with natural aesthetics for 6 landscaping, a biological tool to control water and wind erosion, a renewable source of food, fuel and lumber for man, a 7 habitat for birds and wildlife and a natural producer of oxygen 8 9 and water through the process of transpiration; and WHEREAS, The original "Arbor Day" was observed with the 10 11 planting of more than a million trees; and 12 WHEREAS, Scientists, environmentalists, foresters and 13 government officials throughout the world are increasingly alarmed about the significant clearing and destruction of the 14

1 forests of the world and are now exploring the feasibility of 2 large-scale reforestation programs as a means of preventing a 3 possible adverse climate change such as global warming; and 4 WHEREAS, "Arbor Day" has been designated by many states as a 5 time to recognize the importance of trees to our environment; 6 and

WHEREAS, "Arbor Day" is now celebrated throughout the United 7 8 States and in countries around the world; and 9 WHEREAS, The last Friday in April is commonly held to be the 10 day to celebrate "Arbor Day"; therefore be it 11 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize April 12 29, 2016, as "Arbor Day," promote public participation in the 13 celebration and further recognize the value of trees to our 14 environment; and be it further

15 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives ask that 16 residents and communities throughout this Commonwealth, individually and collectively, engage in the celebration of 17 "Arbor Day" by planting trees in appropriate public places as a 18 19 source of future enjoyment and civic pride; and be it further 20 RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to the Governor and the Senate to solicit support for this 21 recognition. 22
