## AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323, No.130), entitled
- 2 "An act relating to counties of the third, fourth, fifth,
- 3 sixth, seventh and eighth classes; amending, revising,
- 4 consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto, "
- 5 further providing for certain annual assessments.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Section 445(a) of the act of August 9, 1955
- 9 (P.L.323, No.130), known as The County Code, amended July 30,
- 10 1975 (P.L.153, No.77), is amended to read:
- 11 Section 445. Annual Assessments for County Commissioners,
- 12 Etc. -- (a) In addition to the expenses hereinbefore authorized,
- 13 the necessary expenses of the association of county
- 14 commissioners, county solicitors and chief clerks shall be
- 15 apportioned among the counties holding membership in the
- 16 association in amounts provided for by the rules and regulations
- 17 of the association but shall not total more than:
- 18 (1) [twelve hundred dollars (\$1,200)] one thousand five
- 19 hundred dollars (\$1,500) for any county of the third class;

- 1 (2) [one thousand dollars (\$1,000)] one thousand two hundred
- 2 <u>fifty dollars (\$1,250)</u> for any county of the fourth class;
- 3 (3) [eight hundred dollars (\$800)] one thousand dollars
- 4 (\$1,000) for any county of the fifth class;
- 5 (4) [six hundred dollars (\$600)] seven hundred fifty dollars
- 6 (\$750) for any county of the sixth class;
- 7 (5) [four hundred dollars (\$400)] <u>five hundred dollars</u>
- 8 (\$500) for any county of the seventh class; or
- 9 (6) [three hundred dollars (\$300)] three hundred seventy-
- 10 five dollars (\$375) for any county of the eighth class per
- 11 annum.

- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
