 - "Respiratory Care Week" in Pennsylvania and commending
- 3 respiratory therapists of Lebanon's Good Samaritan Hospital
- 4 and at all hospitals in this Commonwealth for their
- 5 outstanding contributions to health care.
- 6 WHEREAS, "National Respiratory Care Week" will be observed
- 7 October 24 through 30, 2004, nationwide; and
- 8 WHEREAS, This observance celebrates the contribution that
- 9 respiratory therapists make to our nation's health care system;
