AN ACT

1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
2 act relating to the public school system, including certain
3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
4 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
5 laws relating thereto," providing for the graduation of
6 qualified students, and for certain subsidies and
7 reimbursements.

8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
9 hereby enacts as follows:

10 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
11 as the "Public School Code of 1949," is amended by adding a
12 section to read:

13 Section 1501.3. Nuclear Emergency of 1979.--No school
14 district shall be required to change its graduation schedule or
15 require graduating students to return to school after graduation
16 to make up class days lost due to the emergency conditions
17 existing at the nuclear generating facilities at Three Mile
18 Island during the spring of 1979. No district which makes a bona
19 fide effort as determined by the Secretary of Education to
20 provide one hundred eighty (180) days of instruction for

1 graduating students shall receive less subsidy payments or
2 reimbursements than it would otherwise be entitled to receive on
3 account of the school year 1978-79 because of the provisions of
4 this act.

5 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
