- 1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the
- Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in traffic courts,
- further providing for Traffic Court of Philadelphia; and
- 4 providing for president judge and for masters of Traffic
- 5 Court of Philadelphia.
- The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Section 1321 of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania
- 9 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 10 § 1321. Traffic Court of Philadelphia.
- 11 The Traffic Court of Philadelphia shall be a court not of
- 12 record and shall consist of [seven judges] a president judge and
- 13 <u>six masters</u>. The court is established for the City and County of
- 14 Philadelphia.
- 15 Section 2. Title 42 is amended by adding sections to read:
- 16 § 1322. President judge.
- 17 The president judge of the Traffic Court of Philadelphia
- 18 <u>shall be appointed by the Governor for a term of six years and</u>
- 19 shall supervise the work and administration of the traffic
- 20 <u>court. The president judge may not preside over or adjudicate</u>

- 1 any case or impose any fine or costs.
- 2 § 1323. Masters.
- 3 (a) Oualifications.--In order to be elected, a master must:
- 4 (1) Have at least a bachelor's degree from an accredited
- 5 <u>institution of higher education.</u>
- 6 (2) Have been a resident of the city for a period of not
- 7 <u>less than four years.</u>
- 8 (3) Not been convicted or pleaded nolo contendere to a
- 9 <u>criminal offense graded higher than a summary offense in this</u>
- 10 Commonwealth.
- 11 (4) Not have outstanding parking or moving violations.
- 12 <u>(5) Possess a valid driver's license.</u>
- 13 (6) Have passed a certification examination adopted by
- rule of the president judge of the traffic court.
- 15 (b) Term of office. -- A master shall be elected for a term of
- 16 <u>six years.</u>
- 17 (c) Duties.--A master shall conduct hearings in cases before
- 18 the traffic court and submit proposed findings of fact and
- 19 conclusions of law to the municipal court for final disposition
- 20 of the cases.
- 21 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
