A RESOLUTION

- Designating the month of September 2018 as "Military Service Opportunity Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, "Military Opportunities Day" should be recognized as
- 4 a part of each high school's annual effort to help juniors and
- 5 seniors learn about postsecondary competition strategies in the
- 6 military; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The United States military is recognized as our
- 8 nation's top security force and defender of our national
- 9 interests around the world; and
- 10 WHEREAS, The United States military has a tactical awareness
- 11 in improving student academic achievement nationwide and is
- 12 recognized as our nation's top security force and defender of
- 13 our national interests around the world; and
- 14 WHEREAS, The United States military is one of the leading
- 15 Federal organizations that supports and invests in educational

- 2 WHEREAS, The United States military contributes to the well-
- 3 being of students within this Commonwealth by offering personal
- 4 advancement through educational programs beginning at the high
- 5 school level; and
- 6 WHEREAS, As a valuable asset to all students, military
- 7 members work side-by-side with their civilian counterparts to
- 8 enhance the delivery of high-quality services to our youths; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Military recruiters offer physical fitness
- 10 programming to all students to fight the obesity epidemic in the
- 11 United States; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Military recruiters provide educational programs
- 13 such as leadership development, antibullying, antidrug and
- 14 patriotism and those that enhance the science, technology,
- 15 engineering and mathematics (STEM) curricula; and
- 16 WHEREAS, The United States military has earned the respect of
- 17 the entire world as a leader of technology and personal
- 18 advancement through the protection and defense of civil
- 19 liberties; and
- 20 WHEREAS, United States military members are academically and
- 21 professionally prepared to provide a multitude of career
- 22 services to our nation, including, but not limited to, a full
- 23 range of medical services, cyber security, law enforcement
- 24 services, comprehensive legal services, a full range of
- 25 engineering services, comprehensive satellite technology,
- 26 communications and network development and logistical and
- 27 administrative support; and
- 28 WHEREAS, The United States military has an outstanding
- 29 reputation for recruiting volunteers inspired by a sense of duty
- 30 to the nation and a desire to become members of the world's

- 2 WHEREAS, Members of the United States military are recognized
- 3 for their dedication and contributions to people's lives and for
- 4 working together as a team; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Generations of remarkable citizens have pledged to
- 6 defend our homeland and our nation through service in the Army,
- 7 Navy, Marine Corps, Air Force and Coast Guard, including
- 8 National Guard and Reserve components; and
- 9 WHEREAS, A mission of the United States military is to
- 10 continue offering outstanding career and educational
- 11 opportunities to all students who seek the adventure of service
- 12 to their nation; therefore be it
- 13 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 14 month of September 2018 as "Military Service Opportunity Month"
- 15 in Pennsylvania; and be it further
- 16 RESOLVED, That educational communities of this Commonwealth
- 17 consider offering a "Military Opportunities Day" presentation
- 18 sometime in September during each school year; and be it further
- 19 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives encourage the
- 20 residents and educational communities of this Commonwealth to
- 21 recognize the United States military for its significant impact
- 22 on and contributions to the educational system and its students
- 23 as well as to career planning throughout this nation and this
- 24 Commonwealth.
