AN ACT

1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the  
2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for the  
3 imposition of sentences in certain convictions.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

8 § 9763. Sentence for multiple violations.

9 After a determination of guilt involving a defendant charged  
10 with multiple violations of 18 Pa.C.S. § 2504 (relating to  
11 involuntary manslaughter) or 75 Pa.C.S. § 3732 (relating to  
12 homicide by vehicle), the court imposing sentence shall have the  
13 authority and may impose a specific sentence for each violation  
14 of 18 Pa.C.S. § 2504 or 75 Pa.C.S. § 3732 for which a  
15 determination of guilt has been returned.

1       Section 2.   This act shall take effect in 60 days.
