- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 2 Consolidated Statutes, prohibiting the manufacture, sale or
- 3 possession of certain fireworks.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 18, act of November 25, 1970 (P.L.707,
- 7 No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, is
- 8 amended by adding a section to read:
- 9 § 6163. Fireworks.
- 10 (a) In general. -- Whoever manufacturers, sells or possesses
- 11 fireworks known as or equivalent to Flowers Dancing, Magic
- 12 Roman Candle, Clustering Butterflies, TNT Bomb, Sunflower,
- 13 Clustering Bees, Flower-Scattering Child, Report Rocket, Buzz
- 14 Bomb or Moon Traveller, is quilty of an offense.
- 15 (b) Grading.--
- 16 (1) The manufacturer or sale of fireworks prohibited by
- 17 <u>subsection (a) is a misdemeanor of the third degree.</u>
- 18 (2) The possession of fireworks prohibited by subsection
- 19 <u>(a) is a summary offense.</u>

- 1 (c) Defense. -- It shall be defense to a charge pursuant to
- 2 subsection (a) that the defendant has the appropriate valid
- 3 <u>license or permit from the Federal, State or local government to</u>
- 4 manufacture, sell or possess fireworks.
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
