## AN ACT

1 2 3 4 5	Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in registration of vehicles, further providing for vehicles exempt from registration—; AND, IN SNOWMOBILES AND ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES, PROVIDING FOR REGIONAL ATV PILOT PROGRAM FOR DEPARTMENT LANDS.

8	Section 1. Section 1302(17) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
9	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
10	§ 1302. Vehicles exempt from registration.
11	The following types of vehicles are exempt from registration:
12	* * *
13	(17) Any multipurpose agricultural vehicle. Vehicles
14	exempt from registration under this paragraph shall be used
15	exclusively upon a farm or farms owned or operated by the
16	owner of the vehicles or upon highways between:
17	(i) Parts of one such farm.

1	(ii) Such farms located not more than [five] <u>ten</u>
2	miles apart.

4	SECTION 2. TITLE 75 IS AMENDED BY ADDING A SECTION TO READ: <
5	§ 7731. REGIONAL ATV PILOT PROGRAM FOR DEPARTMENT LANDS.
6	(A) PILOT PROGRAM THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ESTABLISH A
7	REGIONAL PILOT PROGRAM FOR ATV USE ON DEPARTMENT LANDS. THE
8	PILOT PROGRAM SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE FOLLOWING:
9	(1) AS PART OF THE PILOT PROGRAM, BY DECEMBER 31, 2022,
10	THE DEPARTMENT SHALL:
11	(I) EVALUATE THE DEPARTMENT FOREST DISTRICT OF
12	GALLITZIN FOR ROADS AND TRAILS TO SERVE AS POTENTIAL
13	REGIONAL CONNECTORS AND TO PROVIDE LOCAL ACCESS OR SERVE
14	AS A TRAIL COMPLEX FOR ATV USE; AND
15	(II) PERFORM AN ASSESSMENT REGARDING CHARGING FEES
16	FOR ACCESS TO THE DEPARTMENT ATV PILOT AREA.
17	(2) BEGINNING JANUARY 2023, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL:
18	(I) CONSULT WITH LOCAL COMMUNITY LEADERS TO ASSESS
19	THEIR INTEREST IN AND THE FEASIBILITY OF A DEPARTMENT ATV
20	PILOT AREA;
21	(II) PERFORM OUTREACH TO AFFECTED COMMUNITIES AND
22	STAKEHOLDERS; AND
23	(III) MAP, MARK AND DESIGNATE ROADS AND TRAILS IN
24	THE DEPARTMENT ATV PILOT AREA FOR USE AS PERMITTED UNDER
25	THIS SUBSECTION.
26	(3) UPON COMPLETION OF THE REQUIREMENTS UNDER PARAGRAPHS
27	(1) AND (2), THE DEPARTMENT MAY APPLY A FEE AND SELL TAGS FOR

- 3 <u>WEEKEND IN SEPTEMBER, IN ADDITION TO AN EXTENDED SEASON TO BE</u>
- 4 <u>DETERMINED BY THE DEPARTMENT BASED ON LOCAL CONDITIONS.</u>
- 5 (5) IN ORDER TO ACCESS THE DEPARTMENT ATV PILOT AREA
- 6 ROADS OR TRAILS, A PERSON WITH A REGISTRATION UNDER SECTION
- 7 7711.1 (RELATING TO REGISTRATION OF SNOWMOBILE OR ATV) MUST
- 8 APPLY FOR, OBTAIN AND PROMINENTLY DISPLAY A DEPARTMENT ATV
- 9 <u>PILOT AREA TAG UPON THE ATV.</u>
- 10 (6) THE FEE PER TAG SHALL BE DETERMINED BY THE
- 11 DEPARTMENT DURING THE PILOT PROGRAM ASSESSMENT UNDER
- 12 PARAGRAPH (2) (I). THE TAGS SHALL BE DISPERSED ON A CALENDAR-
- 13 <u>YEAR BASIS.</u>
- 14 (7) ALL FEES COLLECTED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE
- 15 <u>DEPOSITED INTO THE RESTRICTED ACCOUNT AS PROVIDED FOR UNDER</u>
- 16 SECTION 7706(A)(1) (RELATING TO RESTRICTED ACCOUNTS) AND
- 17 SHALL BE ALLOCATED TO THE DEPARTMENT'S ATV FUND WHICH FUNDS
- 18 ATV ACTIVITIES, ENFORCEMENT AND MAINTENANCE ON DEPARTMENT
- 19 LANDS UNDER SECTION 7706(B).
- 20 (8) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL MONITOR THE USE, ENFORCEMENT,
- 21 MAINTENANCE NEEDS AND ANY ASSOCIATED IMPACTS TO STATE FOREST
- 22 LAND RESOURCES, VALUE AND FOREST USERS RESULTING FROM THE
- 23 DEPARTMENT ATV PILOT AREA. ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 2025,
- THE DEPARTMENT SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY
- ON THE DEPARTMENT ATV PILOT AREA.
- 26 (B) EXPIRATION.--THE PILOT PROGRAM SHALL EXPIRE JANUARY 1,
- 27 2026.
- 28 (C) DEFINITIONS.--AS USED IN THIS SECTION, THE FOLLOWING
- 29 WORDS AND PHRASES SHALL HAVE THE MEANINGS GIVEN TO THEM IN THIS
- 30 SUBSECTION UNLESS THE CONTEXT CLEARLY INDICATES OTHERWISE:

- 1 "DEPARTMENT." THE DEPARTMENT OF CONSERVATION AND NATURAL
- 2 <u>RESOURCES OF THE COMMONWEALTH.</u>
- 3 Section  $\frac{2}{3}$ . This act shall take effect  $\frac{1}{3}$   $\frac{60}{3}$  days. AS

- 5 (1) THE AMENDMENT OF 75 PA.C.S. § 1302(17) SHALL TAKE
- 6 EFFECT IN 60 DAYS.
- 7 (2) THE REMAINDER OF THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT
