- 7 Section 1. Section 1102 of Title 66 of the Pennsylvania
- 8 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:
- 9 § 1102. Enumeration of acts requiring certificate.

- 11 (c) Uncontested telecommunication applications.--The
- 12 commission may not review an uncontested application of a
- 13 telecommunication public utility seeking any acquisition,
- 14 merger, sale of stocks, transfer of assets or transfer of
- 15 control which requires a certificate of public convenience for a
- 16 period of more than 60 days. Upon the expiration of the 60-day
- 17 review period, the application shall be deemed approved. In
- 18 reviewing an uncontested application under this subsection, the
- 19 commission may not:

- 1 (1) require or impose conditions on an applicant that
  2 are dependent on a Federal or any other State proceeding
  3 relating to the application filing; or
  4 (2) impose conditions of approval beyond the scope of
  5 the commission's jurisdiction.
- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
