AN ACT

1 Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1225, No.316), entitled
2 "An act concerning game and other wild birds and wild
3 animals; and amending, revising, consolidating, and changing
4 the law relating thereto," removing the maximum amount which
5 may be expended annually by the commission for the payment of
6 bear damage protection or bear damage claims.

7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8 hereby enacts as follows:

9 Section 1. Section 1304, act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1225,
10 No.316), known as "The Game Law," amended June 11, 1968
11 (P.L.162, No.91), is amended to read:

12 Section 1304. Amount Available for Bear Damages.--[Not to
13 exceed seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$7,500) annually]
14 Such amount of money as shall be deemed necessary may be
15 expended by the commission from the Game Fund for the payment of
16 such bear damage protection, or bear damage claims, filed and
17 adjusted in accordance with the provisions of this article.

18 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
