- 10 (b) Disabled veterans. --
- 11 Any resident disabled veteran who has a disability
- 12 incurred in any war or armed conflict which consists of the
- 13 loss of one or more limbs, or the loss of the use of one or
- 14 more limbs, or who is 100% disabled as certified by the
- 15 United States Department of Veterans Affairs, and who meets
- 16 all other qualifications of this title and is otherwise
- mentally and physically fit, shall [be issued a free regular 17
- hunting or furtaking license], upon application to the 18

commission or a county treasurer[.], be issued any of the 1 following licenses or permits without cost or fee under 2 section 2709(a) (relating to license costs and fees): 3 4 (i) Regular hunting. (ii) Regular furtaking. 5 6 (iii) Antlerless deer. <u>(iv) Bear.</u> 7 (v) Archery. 8 9 (vi) Muzzleloader. (vii) Migratory game bird. 10 (viii) Elk. 11 (ix) Special wild turkey. 12 (x) Pheasant, as provided under 58 Pa. Code § 13 14 147.317 (relating to permit). 15 * * * Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
