AS AMENDED ON THIRD CONSIDERATION, HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, MARCH 20, 1984

AN ACT

1 Designating the entire portion of Interstate Route 81 in
2 Pennsylvania as the American Legion Memorial Highway;
3 DESIGNATING THE ENTIRE PORTION OF KEYSTONE HIGHWAY INTERSTATE <—
4 ROUTE 80 IN PENNSYLVANIA AS THE VETERANS OF FOREIGN WARS OF
5 THE UNITED STATES/Z. H. CONFAIR MEMORIAL HIGHWAY; requiring
6 the Department of Transportation to erect signs designating
7 Fort Indiantown Gap National Cemetery; and making an
8 appropriation.

9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
10 hereby enacts as follows:

11 Section 1. The entire portion of Interstate Route 81 situate
12 in Pennsylvania shall hereafter be known as the American Legion
13 Memorial Highway.

14 Section 2. The Department of Transportation shall erect
15 appropriate signs on Interstate Route 81 indicating Fort
16 Indiantown Gap National Cemetery.

17 SECTION 3. THE ENTIRE PORTION OF KEYSTONE HIGHWAY INTERSTATE <—
18 ROUTE 80 SITUATE IN PENNSYLVANIA SHALL HEREAFTER BE KNOWN AS THE
19 VETERANS OF FOREIGN WARS OF THE UNITED STATES/Z. H. CONFAIR
20 MEMORIAL HIGHWAY.

1 Section 3 4. The Department of Transportation shall erect <—
2 the appropriate signs to indicate ~~this highway designation~~ THESE <—
3 HIGHWAY DESIGNATIONS to the motoring public.

4 Section 4 5. The sum of \$8,000 is appropriated to the <—
5 Department of Transportation to carry out the purposes of
6 section 2 of this act.

7 Section 5 6. This act shall take effect immediately. <—
