AN ACT

- Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled 2 "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the 3 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the Executive Department thereof and the administrative 4 5 departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, 6 including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or 7 8 authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative 9 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative 10 officers, and of the several administrative departments, 11 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the 12 13 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive 14 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and 15 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, 16 17 and commissions; and prescribing the manner in which the number and compensation of the deputies and all other assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and 18 19 20 commissions shall be determined, "imposing restrictions on 21 the utilization of PennSERVE moneys for certain compensation; 22 and making a repeal. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

- 25 Section 1. Section 2203-B of the act of April 9, 1929
- 26 (P.L.177, No.175), known as The Administrative Code of 1929, is
- 27 amended by adding a subsection to read:

- 1 Section 2203-B. Responsibilities of Office.--* * *
- 2 (e) The expenditure of money by PennSERVE for the
- 3 compensation of participants, other than PennSERVE employes, in
- 4 <u>a community service program, or in any other program established</u>
- 5 by a community-based agency or by the Commonwealth or a
- 6 political subdivision, is prohibited.
- 7 Section 2. Section 2204-B(2)(iii) of the act is repealed.
- 8 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
